  - **VIP at the Pagoda** pass and credentials are included in your registration package (a \$50 value)
    - provides an air-conditioned private area for patrons to view the seaplane operations, air shows, hydroplane race and D-Day re-enactment in the comfort of the beautiful Pagoda
    - Catered lunch and dinner meals Friday and Saturday and lunch Sunday
    - CLEAN Restrooms
    - Guided tour of the only operational LST
  - Courtesy transportation Van and driver provided for Splash-In / Fly-In participants. Provides shuttle service to the two airports, riverfront, hiking trails, shopping, etc.

- Be sure to check the Splash-In website <http://www.newtech.com/flyin> for the scheduled times the river will be closed to arrivals due to the airshow.
- The Evansville River Front is under the outer tier of EVV's Class C airspace BUT there is WAIVERED AIRSPACE when the aerobatic box is hot for the airshow; It is a good idea to call EVV Approach Control on 126.4 and tell them your intentions to land on the Ohio River for the EAA Splash-In; Approach will be able to advise you if the airshow box is hot.
- The riverfront crew will be monitoring (frequency will be announced prior to fly-in)
- Riverfront docking for passenger loading and unloading is available at the riverfront plaza.
- Limited seaplane daytime tie-down buoys will be available; and there will be tender boats available for shuttle service between your plane and the Riverfront Plaza
- Depending on river conditions, you may be able to tie down on the Kentucky side beach and very primitively “camp with your plane”, i.e. no services or electric
- 100LL fuel available at the Riverfront Plaza
- **Amphibians and Land Planes** can overnight at:
  - Lower Riverfront Ramp (amphibians only)
  - Evansville Regional Airport KEVV (Class C) tie-down and hangar facilities are available at FBO Tri-State Aero
  - Skylane 3EV (grass)
  - Camp with your plane on one of the nicer grass fields around
- Continental breakfast served Saturday and Sunday mornings
- Restroom facilities available
- Local transportation provided by courtesy van
- **No overnight accommodations are available for straight float aircraft at Evansville; however, Check with Rising Sun Seaplane Base (67IN)**
- **Hotel accommodations**
  - Discounted group rates for Splash-In / Fly-In participants at the same hotel where the airshow performers are staying

  - LST 325 <http://www.lstmemorial.org/> **USS LST 325** participated in several operations, most notable was D-Day at Omaha Beach, Normandy. She was there for Operation HUSKY, the invasion of Sicily in 1943. She sailed as support for the invasion of Salerno, Italy later that year. This ship has seen 70 years of history and survived as the last fully-operational WWII LST. Come walk these decks and feel the

connection to our shared past.

- And did we say: Seaplane Fly-In, Land Plane Fly-In, Awesome Airshow, Unlimited Hydroplane Race, two of the six flying P-47 Thunderbolts, the only operational WWII LST, a Grumman Albatross whose fuselage was made here in Evansville **and** all your friends and flying buddies
